Let's break it down. The upfront cost used to scare folks off, but wait - prices have dropped 62% since 2016. A typical 6.6kW system now costs \$4,500-\$7,000 after rebates. That's cheaper than most family vacations! Plus, Victoria's Solar Homes Program throws in up to \$1,400 rebate. Makes you wonder - is this the best time ever to switch?

### Picking Your Best Solar System: Size Matters

Here's where people mess up. They either go too small ("Just 3kW should do") or overspend on unnecessary tech. A 3-bedroom house in Ballarat needs different gear than a Mornington Peninsula mansion. The sweet spot?

- 5kW system for 2-3 person households
- 6.6kW for families with teens
- 10kW+ if you've got an EV or pool

But hold on - panel efficiency varies wildly. Tier-1 brands like Jinko Solar hit 22% conversion rates, while bargain-bin options barely crack 15%. That difference could mean 1,200kWh extra yearly. Would you rather save \$800 now or \$3,200 over a decade?
