- Ignoring firmware updates - yes, your controller needs those too!
- Using automotive fuses instead of proper PV breakers

Phase 1: Pre-Installation Checks

Pro Tips for 20% More Efficiency

You know what's cooler than saving the planet? Saving money while doing it. Try these controller hacks:

Enable "Equalization Charge" monthly - it's like a spa day for batteries

Set load priority to "Lighting First" if using mixed appliances

The Coffee Maker Conundrum

Imagine this: Your 800W coffee maker kicks on at 6 AM when solar input's still low. The controller panics, the battery drains...and you get cold brew. Solution? Program delayed start until 7:30 AM using the Eco Worthy solar controller's timer function.
